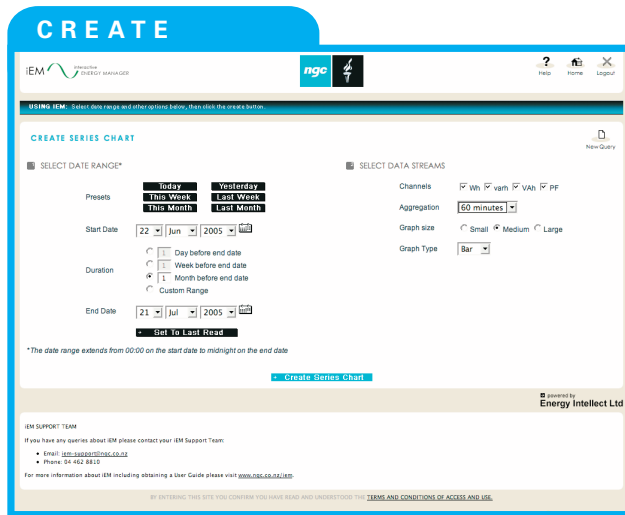


How does it work?

Time interval metering data from your site is sent electronically to the iEM platform. Your electricity data is available for your review and analysis at a frequency that best suits your budget. iEM enables you to compare multiple metered sites and use tools to analyse specific time periods of your choosing.

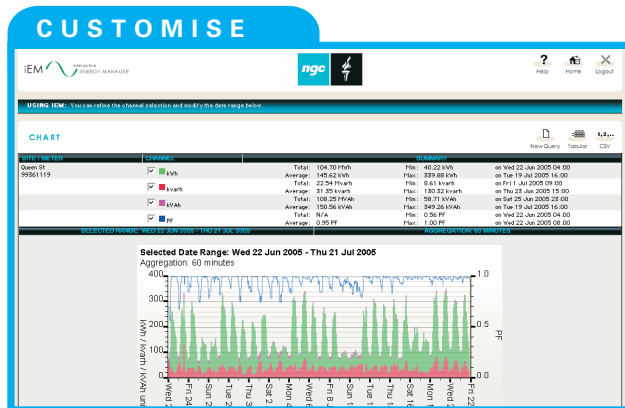

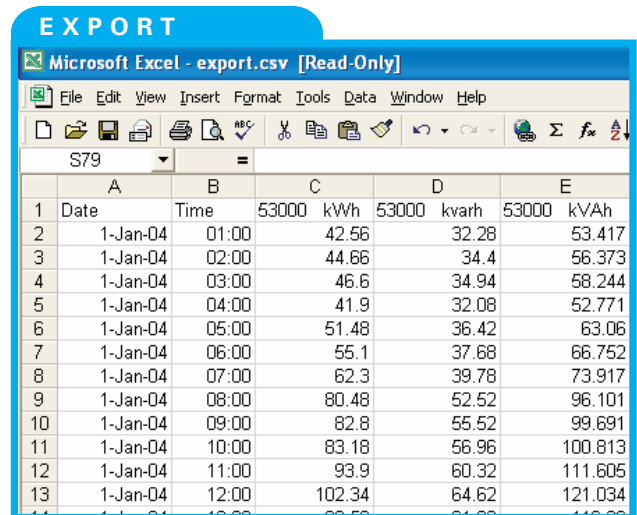
Creating energy consumption charts couldn't be easier. Simply input the desired date range, data streams and level of aggregation.
